#### 2021 Coordinated Election Dates:

- ✓ Thursday, September 16<sup>th</sup>, 11am: Public Logic & Accuracy Testing for voting system hardware (Old Courthouse)
- ✓ Friday, September 17<sup>th</sup>: UOCAVA ballots will be mailed to active Military/Overseas Voters
- ✓ Tuesday, October 12<sup>th</sup> through Friday, October 15<sup>th</sup>: Ballots will be mailed to ALL active, registered voters
- ✓ Monday, October 25<sup>th</sup>: Montrose Voter Service Polling Center (VSPC) opens at the Old Courthouse
- ✓ Monday October 25<sup>th</sup>: Last day for a voter to request a ballot to be mailed to them
- ✓ Friday, October 29<sup>th</sup>: West End Voter Service Polling Center (VSPC) opens at the Nucla-Naturita Chamber of Commerce
- ✓ Tuesday, November 2<sup>nd</sup>: ELECTION DAY—Voter Service Polling Centers open from 7:00am to 7:00pm
